#### **BRIEF HISTORY**

M'salem School Complex was established in September, 2005 at Kpone Saduase off the Dodowa-Oyibi road in the Greater Accra Region. We are fully committed to providing quality education at all stages of the academic ladder from Pre-school through to the Junior High School with our committed and dedicated staff. The school's motto 'In God we trust' has inspired us to strive higher as the sky is our limit.

#### **MISSION**

The key aim of the school is to train, guide and nurture, instill discipline and the fear of God as well as impact academic knowledge in pupils.

#### VISION

We seek to become a highly progressive institution with academic excellence. Thereby creating a safe, secured and friendly environment to promote teaching and learning.

#### **DAY OPTION**

M'salem School Complex is a day school and therefore offers only day services.

#### **ADMISSIONS**

Admission is done all year round (September-August). Vacancies are also available for all classes from crèche to second year of Junior High School

Those who gain admission into M'salem School Complex will submit the following:

- Completed admission forms
- · A (1) passport-size photograph
- · Previous term's report

Cumulative records/testimonial from previous school.

### **SCHOOL FEES**

- · Fees are payable on or before the beginning of the term
- Payments can be made via momo/school's bank account /office
- Parents must demand an official receipt on payment of any amount.
- Fees must be paid promptly.
- It is an offence for any student who has not paid his/her fees to report to school after the grace period.
- Fees paid are not refundable. All fees must be paid on or before mid-terms.
- A Pupil sacked for fees when in school will not be allowed to go home unless a parent/guardian request to pick him /her from the school's premises.

#### **SCHOOL HOURS**

School begins at 7:10am and closes at 3:20pm. JHS 1&2 are given extra tuition on Mondays, Tuesdays & Thursdays from 4:00pm - 5:30pm whilst the final year students are given extra tuition from 4:00pm - 5:30pm; Monday -Friday. No student should leave the school premises between 7:10am and 3:20pm without permission from school authority.

## **PUNCTUALITY AT SCHOOL/FUNCTIONS**

Students should note that all school functions are compulsory e.g. Morning Assembly, Wednesday worship, Graduation ceremonies, opening and closing assemblies.

#### **TEACHING STAFF**

Our teachers show passion and love for their job because our recruitment has always targeted dedicated, highly qualified,

experienced, dynamic and resourceful staff.

#### **APPEARANCE**

Students must be neat, decent in appearance, and must always wear the prescribed uniform and footwear.

## **Girls**

- 1. Wearing of hijab is not accepted on the premises.
- 2. All girls should wear small ear-rings with mild colours.
- 3. Footwear should be noiseless. Slippers shall not be worn.
- 4. Hair should be kept neat whether plaited or natural. There should be no artificial attachment. Cut hair should be low.
- 5. There should be no make-ups (e.g. Bangles, rings, necklaces, Rosary chain, painted nails etc.)
- All uniform should have the School crest.

## **Boys**

- 1. All boys should wear the prescribed uniform and footwear
- Hair should be natural and evenly low.
- 3. Footwear should be noiseless. Slippers shall not be worn.
- 4. All uniform should have the School crest.

NOTE: These rules apply to all categories of people. All uniforms (sown/material) are to be purchased in the school and should have the school's crest.

## MID-TERM HOLIDAYS/PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

A day(s) is set aside during the 3<sup>rd</sup> term for parents to personally observe the performance of their wards by going through their books and also have interaction with the teachers. We also encourage Parents to visit the school intermittently aside this days.

## SPEECH / GRADUATION DAY

This is an annual programme organized every 3<sup>rd</sup> term after vacation for the whole school. The ceremony is held to usher the KG2 and Basic 6 pupils to Basic 1 & JHS1 respectively. Also, deserving pupils and staff are awarded during the ceremony.

## PARENT TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (P.T.A)

M'salem School Complex has a strong P.T.A where meetings are held at least once every term. Therefore all parents/guardians are encouraged to actively get involved.

#### **FIRST AID**
